Policy Statement

Rose Dance Studios is committed to providing a safe, respectful, inclusive, and positive environment where all students can learn, grow, and enjoy dance.

Expected Behaviour - Students

All students are expected to:

- Treat teachers, staff and fellow students with respect and kindness.
- Follow instructions promptly and safely.
- Participate positively and try their best.
- Respect studio property, equipment and facilities.
- Use appropriate language at all times.
- Behave safely, particularly during physical activities and use of equipment.

Unacceptable Behaviour

The following behaviours are not permitted:

- Bullying, harassment, intimidation or discrimination of any kind.
- Physical aggression or unsafe conduct.
- Disruptive behaviour that interferes with teaching or learning.
- Inappropriate language, gestures or online behaviour.
- Deliberate damage to property or equipment.
- Failure to follow health & safety instructions.

Rose Dance Studios reserves the right to take immediate action where behaviour poses a risk to safety.

Parent / Guardian Expectations

Parents and guardians are expected to:

- Support studio policies and expectations.
- Communicate respectfully with staff at all times.
- Address concerns through appropriate channels.
- Ensure students arrive on time, dressed appropriately and ready to participate.
- Refrain from disruptive behaviour within studio premises.
- Parents/Guardians must not film any classes without prior permission.

Rose Dance Studios operates a zero-tolerance approach to violence, bullying, discrimination and serious safeguarding breaches. Behaviour that compromises the safety or wellbeing of students may result in immediate, temporary or permanent removal from classes without refund.

All safeguarding concerns are recorded and managed in line with Rose Dance Studios' Safeguarding Policy.
